FOSTER AGREEMENT:

By signing this application, you agree to the following:

I will provide love and affection for my foster Bulldog as I would my own dog.

I will be responsible for all toys and treats. (Rags To Royals will provide food.)

I will purchase hygiene products (shampoo, baby wipes, ear cleanser, etc.) for my foster Bulldog's routine maintenance.

I will care for my foster by cleaning skin folds, tail pockets, ears, eyes, etc. as directed by the rescue.

Rags To Royals will pay for any and all VETERINARY care to include all medications and preventatives. If I choose to use a veterinarian not affiliated with the rescue (other than emergencies outside of the vet's hours), I will be responsible for all costs above the rescue price.

If my foster dog needs a crate and Rags To Royals cannot provide one, I will purchase a wire crate large enough for my foster to stand up, turn around and be comfortable. I will purchase blankets, towels or pads to line the crate. If applicable to my foster, he/she will remain in a crate when I am unable to provide supervision.

I will slowly introduce the foster to my other animals. I will supervise all introductions. If needed, I will keep my foster separated from my other animals.

CRATING CAUTION COURTESY OF THE HUMANE SOCIETY'S SITE:

A crate is NOT a magical solution. If not used correctly, a dog can feel trapped and frustrated.

Don't leave your dog in the crate too long. A dog who's crated day and night doesn't get enough exercise or human interaction and can become depressed or anxious. You may have to change your schedule, hire a pet sitter, or take your dog to doggie daycare to reduce the amount of time he must spend in his crate.

Puppies under six months of age shouldn't stay in a crate for more than 3 or 4 hours at a time. They can't control their bladders and bowels for that long. The same goes for adult dogs who are being housetrained.

Crate your dog only until you can trust him not to destroy the house. After that, it should be a place he goes voluntarily.
